LANGUAGE

The *de facto* language in Uganda is English and Luganda.

TIME ZONE

Uganda is on **GMT+3**

CLIMATE AND WEATHER (KAMPALA)

The average daily temperature in September is 20°C (68°F) with an Average high temperature of 28°C (82.4°F) and an average low temperature of 15°C (59°F).

Be sure to carry an umbrella, and lightweight clothing for the sunny days. But don't forget a light jacket or something with long sleeves for the cooler nights and cloudy evenings.

CURRENCY & EXCHANGE

The unit currency is the Ugandan Shilling (UGX.). Bank notes are available in denominations of UGX. 1,000, 2,000, 5,000, 10,000, 20,000, and 50,000. UGX. 500, 200, 100 and 50 are also available in coins.

It's advisable to tell your bank that you will be traveling to Uganda to avoid any transaction being flagged as fraudulent. Make sure to keep all the receipts from the ATMs when using your credit card. Check the fees and cash withdraw limits applicable before you leave as well.

Currency can be exchanged in foreign exchange bureaus or banks. Most banks operate between 8.30 am – 5.00 pm on weekdays and 09:00 am – 2:00 pm on Saturdays.

Easiest currency to exchange is the US Dollar or Euro. The *current* exchange rate is **US \$1 = UGX. 3,721.88** and **€1 = UGX. 4,062.05**. This may vary depending on the bank or Forex bureau.



DIALING CODES AND MOBILE SERVICE PROVIDERS

+256 is the international dialing code for Kenya.

MTN Uganda and Airtel Uganda are the largest mobile networks in Uganda, and they offer competitive rates on their services. Uganda is GSM compatible so you can activate the Roaming feature and use your mobile. Be sure to talk to your mobile carrier about the compatible networks. Local Sim cards are also available at the airport.
